

EYFS: treat others as you want to be treated


- Children are engaged with the wider community.
- Children know about similarities and differences between themselves and others and among families, faiths, communities, cultures and traditions and share and discuss practices, celebrations and experiences.
- Teachers encourage and explain the importance of tolerant behaviours such as sharing and respecting other's opinions.
- Teachers share stories that reflect and value the diversity of children's experiences and provide resources and activities that challenge gender, cultural and racial stereotyping.

YEAR 1

- We know some people are different to us and that is ok.
- We treat everybody the same.
- We learn about what other people do.
- We have learnt about Buddhists, Hindus, Sikhs and Christians.
- We respect other people and their beliefs


YEAR 2

- We know we could listen or say something kind to people.
- Our school rules teach us to be kind.
- We respect people from different countries and treat them nicely
- We learn about different religions and festivals, and are able to do a range of activities.



Tolerance of Different Faiths and Beliefs

- *Linked to respect, caring and fairness from our school values.*
- *Taught through the religious education curriculum and a wide range of assemblies where festivals from a range of religions are celebrated.*



YEAR 3

- We are kind to others
- We do not laugh at people's beliefs or cultures
- We listen to their ideas
- We do not hurt anyone
- We respect what others believe
- We are polite about what other people believe
- We should not bully others or be unkind because of what they believe
- We should not be racist.

YEAR 4

- We learn about others beliefs in class and assembly
- We share other's experiences
- We read the News Magazine to find out about our world.
- We are polite about what other people believe.
- We learn about racism and why it is wrong.
- We share stories that value the diversity of people's experiences.

YEAR 5

- We learn about different faiths and belief (in class and assemblies).
- We do not make fun of people's differences.
- We celebrate children's successes in our Friday celebration assembly.
- Some of our topics help us learn about different cultures and beliefs – Diwali, Hinduism, the Caribbean.
- We regularly watch Newsround; we understand and discuss different current news issues and provides different opinions on events.

YEAR 6

- We listen to other's views and we do not get annoyed with them for thinking differently
- We respect people's beliefs
- We treat others the same as we would like to be treated
- We respect everyone for their individuality; everyone is different and we treat everyone the same.
- We learn about Judaism in our World War II topic and we understand how badly they were treated.
