English :

As (word) readers we will:

- Develop our phonics through Read Write Inc
- Read aloud accurately books that are consistent with their developing phonic knowledge and that do not require them to use other strategies to work out words.
- Reread these books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.
- Listen to and discuss a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction at a level that they can read independently.

As writers we will :

- Use -ing, -ed, -er and -est where no change is needed in the spelling of root words.
- Compose a sentence orally before writing it.
- Reread what they have written to make sure it makes sense.
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives.
- Apply and consolidate understanding by producing a 'Bean Seed Diary'.

As confident speakers we will:

- Listen and respond appropriately to adults and peers.
- Use spoken language to develop understanding through imagining and exploring ideas.
